SIXTH WATCH | SECOND WATCH OF THE DAY

9AM – 12PM - NOON

FORGIVENESS AND HEALING

9AM – 10AM – HOUR ONE;

10AM – 11AM – HOUR TWO;

11AM – 12PM NOON (HOUR OF TRANSITION)

- - A time to pray for supernatural provision to do God's work. (Exodus 11:3-4)
- A time of repentance, forgiveness, and healing of relationships.
- To activate the power of the blood over witchcraft spirits holding you captive.
- To pray for total surrender to God's will.
- To erase the memory of past offense, hurt, pain.
- To release others of any debt owed.
- The sun is at its brightest during the sixth prayer watch.
- However, while Jesus Christ was dying on the cross, darkness fell across the land until about three in the afternoon (Mark 15:25^L, Matthew 27:45^L).
- This was the darkest period known in human history.
- However, in spite of this, God's divine love for mankind shone bright.
- The blood sacrifice of Jesus Christ redeemed mankind and restored his relationship with God, the Father.
- The Apostle Paul says that we should be thankful to God because, through the sacrifice of Jesus Christ, He "hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son: In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins," (Colossians 1:13, KJV^L).
- In light of this, the fifth prayer watch is a time to reflect on the power of the Cross.
- Because of Christ's work on the cross, we have direct access to God and His benefits and blessings.

A time of repentance, forgiveness, and healing of relationships. A time to active the power of the blood over witchcraft spirits holding you captive. A time to cancel any covenant made with lying, perverted, unclean, and defile spirits. A time to erase the memory of past offense, hurt, pain, and disappointment. A time to expect the manifestation of God’s power to touch your life. A time to nail all the works of the flesh to the cross through a repentant heart. A time to pray for a crucified life and total surrender to the work of the cross. A time to pray for supernatural provision to do God’s work (Exodus 11:3-4) A time to release others of any debt owed, and to thank God for absolute forgiveness. A time to root out bitterness, overcome jealousy, and defect anger. A time to silent slandering, backbiting and gossiping spirit. A time to watch as the Lord awaken a deeper revelation of love in your heart.</p>

The second prayer watch of the day or the third hour is between the hours of 9 am – 12 pm. It is during this watch that we are to fulfill our purpose here on earth. Most jobs in the marketplace either begin their shift at 9 am or earlier in the morning. When we go past 9 am in the morning without any production we are considered idle.

It was during this prayer watch at the third hour of 9 am that Jesus was crucified and fulfilled his divine purpose here on earth. Jesus purpose for coming here to earth was for the salvation of all mankind. It is during this time that we are to embrace the cross and pray for a crucified life with Christ. It is also the time to reap the harvest of the things prayed for at dawn.

It was the prayer that Jesus prayed before the breaking of dawn in the Garden of Gethsemane that would be fulfilled at the 9 am hour. The cross that Jesus had to bear and endure for our sakes was so overwhelming that “He prayed that, if it were possible, the awful hour awaiting him might pass him by. “Abba, Father, he cried out,“ everything is possible for you. Please take this cup of suffering away from me. Yet I want your will to be done, not mine.”

Dear Heavenly Father,
