SUICIDE STATISTICS

- **WHY DOES THIS MATTER?**

- Suicide is the [tenth-leading cause of death](#) in the United States. It is the [fourth-leading cause of death](#) for adolescents ages 15-19 globally. In 2019, there were an estimated 3.5 million people who planned a suicide, 1.4 million suicide attempts and [47,511 deaths by suicide](#). Firearms were involved in [half of all suicides](#), and there were more than [twice](#) as many deaths by suicide than by homicide.
- When someone dies by suicide, as with any cause of death, the loss is felt by many people. The [ripples of loss](#) spread from close family and friends to community members, acquaintances and even people the deceased did not know. All of those exposed to the loss may experience different levels of grief and trauma.
- Societal costs associated with suicide and suicide attempts are estimated at [\\$93.5 billion](#). These costs include lifetime medical fees and lost work costs.
- Mental health disorders and substance use disorders are the most [significant risk factors](#) for suicidal behaviors. In addition, [environmental factors](#) such as stressful life events and access to lethal means such as firearms or drugs may increase the risk of suicide. Previous suicide attempts and a family history of suicide are also important [risk factors](#).

SUICIDE STATISTICS

- **WHO IS AFFECTED?**
- Populations with disproportionately high suicide rates include:
- Men, who have a suicide rate 3.7 times higher than women.
- American Indian/Alaska Native population, who experience the highest suicide rates in the nation, followed by the non-Hispanic white population. Suicide rates among Hispanic, Black and Asian/Pacific Islander populations are significantly lower than rates among American Indian/Alaska Native and white populations.
- Veterans compared with non-veteran adults.
- Those living in rural areas compared with those living in urban areas.
- LGBTQ adults and youth compared with heterosexual adults and youth.

SUICIDE STATISTICS

- **WHAT WORKS?** Strategies to reduce suicide include:
- [Universal screening](#) at emergency rooms to identify patients at higher risk of suicide.
- [Safety planning](#) at emergency rooms to assist patients with suicidal behaviors by providing them with a prioritized list of evidence-based coping strategies and sources of support.
- [Cognitive behavioral therapy](#) to identify and manage suicidal thoughts.
- [Reducing access to lethal means](#) such as firearms, lethal doses of medications and alcohol. Evidence from studies over the past two decades shows a strong association between the [presence of a firearm](#) in the home and an increased risk of suicide for the gun owner and the gun owner's spouse and children. At the community level, the [Gun Shop Project](#) builds partnerships between firearms businesses and public health experts to provide firearm suicide prevention educational materials to firearms retailers, instructors and customers.

- **WHAT WORKS?** Strategies to reduce suicide include:
- Devoting resources to the [ten public health domains](#) of suicide prevention outlined in The State of State, Tribal and Territorial Suicide Prevention report.
- [The Suicide Prevention Resource Center \(SPRC\)](#) has detailed resources for implementing effective suicide prevention in schools and universities, emergency departments, American Indian/Alaska Native communities and other organizations that serve populations at risk for suicide. Additionally, the [National Suicide Prevention Lifeline](#) (1-800-273-TALK, or 1-800-273-8255) is available around the clock for support and resources.
- **GOALS**
- Reducing the suicide rate from 14.2 to 12.8 suicides per 100,000 population is a Healthy People 2030 [objective](#).

WHY SHOULD THE CHURCH/CHRISTIANS CARE ABOUT THIS TOPIC?

- **John 10: 1 – 42** Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that entereth not by the door into the sheepfold, but climbeth up some other way, the same is a thief and a robber.
- **²** But he that entereth in by the door is the shepherd of the sheep.
- **³** To him the porter openeth; and the sheep hear his voice: and he calleth his own sheep by name, and leadeth them out.
- **⁴** And when he putteth forth his own sheep, he goeth before them, and the sheep follow him: for they know his voice.
- **⁵** And a stranger will they not follow, but will flee from him: for they know not the voice of strangers.
- **⁶** This parable spake Jesus unto them: but they understood not what things they were which he spake unto them.
- **⁷** Then said Jesus unto them again, Verily, verily, I say unto you, I am the door of the sheep.

WHY SHOULD THE CHURCH/CHRISTIANS CARE ABOUT THIS TOPIC?

- John 10:8 – 15⁸ All that ever came before me are thieves and robbers: but the sheep did not hear them.**
- ⁹ I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.**
- ¹⁰ The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.**
- ¹¹ I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.**
- ¹² But he that is an hireling, and not the shepherd, whose own the sheep are not, seeth the wolf coming, and leaveth the sheep, and fleeth: and the wolf catcheth them, and scattereth the sheep.**
- ¹³ The hireling fleeth, because he is an hireling, and careth not for the sheep.**
- ¹⁴ I am the good shepherd, and know my sheep, and am known of mine.**
- ¹⁵ As the Father knoweth me, even so know I the Father: and I lay down my life for the sheep.**

WHY SHOULD THE CHURCH/CHRISTIANS CARE ABOUT THIS TOPIC?

- **John 10:16 – 23 And other sheep I have, which are not of this fold: them also I must bring, and they shall hear my voice; and there shall be one fold, and one shepherd.**
- **¹⁷ Therefore doth my Father love me, because I lay down my life, that I might take it again.**
- **¹⁸ No man taketh it from me, but I lay it down of myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This commandment have I received of my Father.**
- **¹⁹ There was a division therefore again among the Jews for these sayings.**
- **²⁰ And many of them said, He hath a devil, and is mad; why hear ye him?**
- **²¹ Others said, These are not the words of him that hath a devil. Can a devil open the eyes of the blind?**
- **²² And it was at Jerusalem the feast of the dedication, and it was winter.**
- **²³ And Jesus walked in the temple in Solomon's porch.**

WHY SHOULD THE CHURCH/CHRISTIANS CARE ABOUT THIS TOPIC?

- **John 10:24 – 32** Then came the Jews round about him, and said unto him, How long dost thou make us to doubt? If thou be the Christ, tell us plainly.
- **25** Jesus answered them, I told you, and ye believed not: the works that I do in my Father's name, they bear witness of me.
- **26** But ye believe not, because ye are not of my sheep, as I said unto you.
- **27** My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:
- **28** And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.
- **29** My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand.
- **30** I and my Father are one.
- **31** Then the Jews took up stones again to stone him.
- **32** Jesus answered them, Many good works have I shewed you from my Father; for which of those works do ye stone me?

WHY SHOULD THE CHURCH/CHRISTIANS CARE ABOUT THIS TOPIC?

- **John 10:33 – 42** The Jews answered him, saying, For a good work we stone thee not; but for blasphemy; and because that thou, being a man, makest thyself God.
- ³⁴ Jesus answered them, Is it not written in your law, I said, Ye are gods?
- ³⁵ If he called them gods, unto whom the word of God came, and the scripture cannot be broken;
- ³⁶ Say ye of him, whom the Father hath sanctified, and sent into the world, Thou blasphemest; because I said, I am the Son of God?
- ³⁷ **If I do not the works of my Father, believe me not.**
- ³⁸ **But if I do, though ye believe not me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is in me, and I in him.**
- ³⁹ **Therefore they sought again to take him: but he escaped out of their hand,**
- ⁴⁰ **And went away again beyond Jordan into the place where John at first baptized; and there he abode.**
- ⁴¹ **And many resorted unto him, and said, John did no miracle: but all things that John spake of this man were true.**
- ⁴² **And many believed on him there.**

JUDAS ISCARIOT

THE BETRAYER....BUT NOT ONLY THE BETRAYER – ONE OF THE CHOSEN 12

- **Matthew 10:1– 12** And when he had called unto him his twelve disciples, he gave them power against unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease.
- **2** Now the names of the twelve apostles are these; The first, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother; James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother;
- **3** Philip, and Bartholomew; Thomas, and Matthew the publican; James the son of Alphaeus, and Lebbaeus, whose surname was Thaddaeus;
- **4** Simon the Canaanite, and Judas Iscariot, who also betrayed him.
- **5** These twelve Jesus sent forth, and commanded them, saying, Go not into the way of the Gentiles, and into any city of the Samaritans enter ye not:
- **6** But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.
- **7** And as ye go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- **8** Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.
- **9** Provide neither gold, nor silver, nor brass in your purses,
- **10** Nor scrip for your journey, neither two coats, neither shoes, nor yet staves: for the workman is worthy of his meat.
- **11** And into whatsoever city or town ye shall enter, enquire who in it is worthy; and there abide till ye go thence.
- **12** And when ye come into an house, salute it.

A WORTHY HOUSE AND ENDURING UNTIL THE END!

- **Matthew 10:13 – 25** ¹³ And if the house be worthy, let your peace come upon it: but if it be not worthy, let your peace return to you.
- ¹⁴ And whosoever shall not receive you, nor hear your words, when ye depart out of that house or city, shake off the dust of your feet.
- ¹⁵ Verily I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for the land of Sodom and Gomorrha in the day of judgment, than for that city.
- ¹⁶ Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.
- ¹⁷ But beware of men: for they will deliver you up to the councils, and they will scourge you in their synagogues;
- ¹⁸ And ye shall be brought before governors and kings for my sake, for a testimony against them and the Gentiles.
- ¹⁹ **But when they deliver you up, take no thought how or what ye shall speak: for it shall be given you in that same hour what ye shall speak.**
- ²⁰ **For it is not ye that speak, but the Spirit of your Father which speaketh in you.**
- ²¹ **And the brother shall deliver up the brother to death, and the father the child: and the children shall rise up against their parents, and cause them to be put to death.**
- ²² **And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake: but he that endureth to the end shall be saved.**
- ²³ **But when they persecute you in this city, flee ye into another: for verily I say unto you, Ye shall not have gone over the cities of Israel, till the Son of man be come.**
- ²⁴ **The disciple is not above his master, nor the servant above his lord.**
- ²⁵ **It is enough for the disciple that he be as his master, and the servant as his lord. If they have called the master of the house Beelzebub, how much more shall they call them of his household?**

IN THE NAME OF A PROPHET? WHAT'S THE REWARD?

- **Matthew 10:26 – 42** Fear them not therefore: for there is nothing covered, that shall not be revealed; and hid, that shall not be known.
- ²⁷ What I tell you in darkness, that speak ye in light: and what ye hear in the ear, that preach ye upon the housetops.
- ²⁸ And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.
- ²⁹ Are not two sparrows sold for a farthing? and one of them shall not fall on the ground without your Father.
- ³⁰ But the very hairs of your head are all numbered.
- ³¹ Fear ye not therefore, ye are of more value than many sparrows.
- ³² Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven.
- ³³ But whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father which is in heaven.
- ³⁴ Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword.
- ³⁵ For I am come to set a man at variance against his father, and the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in law against her mother in law.
- ³⁶ And a man's foes shall be they of his own household.
- ³⁷ **He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me.**
- ³⁸ **And he that taketh not his cross, and followeth after me, is not worthy of me.**
- ³⁹ **He that findeth his life shall lose it: and he that loseth his life for my sake shall find it.**
- ⁴⁰ **He that receiveth you receiveth me, and he that receiveth me receiveth him that sent me.**
- ⁴¹ **He that receiveth a prophet in the name of a prophet shall receive a prophet's reward; and he that receiveth a righteous man in the name of a righteous man shall receive a righteous man's reward.**
- ⁴² **And whosoever shall give to drink unto one of these little ones a cup of cold water only in the name of a disciple, verily I say unto you, he shall in no wise lose his reward.**

JUDAS ISCARIOT

OPPORTUNITY TO BETRAY BUT STILL CAME BACK FOR SUPPER

- **Matthew 26:1 – 22** ⁷ There came unto him a woman having an alabaster box of very precious ointment, and poured it on his head, as he sat at meat.
- ⁸ But when his disciples saw it, they had indignation, saying, To what purpose is this waste?
- ⁹ For this ointment might have been sold for much, and given to the poor.
- ¹⁰ When Jesus understood it, he said unto them, Why trouble ye the woman? for she hath wrought a good work upon me.
- ¹¹ For ye have the poor always with you; but me ye have not always.
- ¹² For in that she hath poured this ointment on my body, she did it for my burial.
- ¹³ Verily I say unto you, Wheresoever this gospel shall be preached in the whole world, there shall also this, that this woman hath done, be told for a memorial of her.
- ¹⁴ Then one of the twelve, called Judas Iscariot, went unto the chief priests,
- ¹⁵ And said unto them, What will ye give me, and I will deliver him unto you? And they covenanted with him for thirty pieces of silver.
- ¹⁶ And from that time he sought opportunity to betray him.
- ¹⁷ Now the first day of the feast of unleavened bread the disciples came to Jesus, saying unto him, Where wilt thou that we prepare for thee to eat the passover?
- ¹⁸ And he said, Go into the city to such a man, and say unto him, The Master saith, My time is at hand; I will keep the passover at thy house with my disciples.
- ¹⁹ And the disciples did as Jesus had appointed them; and they made ready the passover.
- ²⁰ Now when the even was come, he sat down with the twelve.
- ²¹ And as they did eat, he said, Verily I say unto you, that one of you shall betray me.
- ²² And they were exceeding sorrowful, and began every one of them to say unto him, Lord, is it I?

JUDAS ISCARIOT THE BETRAYER...."IS IT I?"

- **Matthew 26:23 – 35** ²³ And he answered and said, He that dippeth his hand with me in the dish, the same shall betray me.
- ²⁴ The Son of man goeth as it is written of him: but woe unto that man by whom the Son of man is betrayed! it had been good for that man if he had not been born.
- ²⁵ Then Judas, which betrayed him, answered and said, Master, is it I? He said unto him, Thou hast said.
- ²⁶ And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed it, and brake it, and gave it to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my body.
- ²⁷ And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, Drink ye all of it;
- ²⁸ For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.
- ²⁹ But I say unto you, I will not drink henceforth of this fruit of the vine, until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom.
- ³⁰ And when they had sung an hymn, they went out into the mount of Olives.
- ³¹ Then saith Jesus unto them, All ye shall be offended because of me this night: for it is written, I will smite the shepherd, and the sheep of the flock shall be scattered abroad.
- ³² But after I am risen again, I will go before you into Galilee.
- ³³ Peter answered and said unto him, Though all men shall be offended because of thee, yet will I never be offended.
- ³⁴ Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee, That this night, before the cock crow, thou shalt deny me thrice.
- ³⁵ Peter said unto him, Though I should die with thee, yet will I not deny thee. Likewise also said all the disciples.

JUDAS ISCARIOT

THE BETRAYER...BUT AWAKE WHILE OTHERS SLEPT

- **Matthew 26:36 – 50** ³⁶ Then cometh Jesus with them unto a place called Gethsemane, and saith unto the disciples, Sit ye here, while I go and pray yonder.
- ³⁷ And he took with him Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, and began to be sorrowful and very heavy.
- ³⁸ Then saith he unto them, My soul is exceeding sorrowful, even unto death: tarry ye here, and watch with me.
- ³⁹ And he went a little farther, and fell on his face, and prayed, saying, O my Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not as I will, but as thou wilt.
- ⁴⁰ And he cometh unto the disciples, and findeth them asleep, and saith unto Peter, What, could ye not watch with me one hour?
- ⁴¹ Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.
- ⁴² He went away again the second time, and prayed, saying, O my Father, if this cup may not pass away from me, except I drink it, thy will be done.
- ⁴³ And he came and found them asleep again: for their eyes were heavy.
- ⁴⁴ And he left them, and went away again, and prayed the third time, saying the same words.
- ⁴⁵ **Then cometh he to his disciples, and saith unto them, Sleep on now, and take your rest: behold, the hour is at hand, and the Son of man is betrayed into the hands of sinners.**
- ⁴⁶ **Rise, let us be going: behold, he is at hand that doth betray me.**
- ⁴⁷ **And while he yet spake, lo, Judas, one of the twelve, came, and with him a great multitude with swords and staves, from the chief priests and elders of the people.**
- ⁴⁸ **Now he that betrayed him gave them a sign, saying, Whomsoever I shall kiss, that same is he: hold him fast.**
- ⁴⁹ **And forthwith he came to Jesus, and said, Hail, master; and kissed him.**
- ⁵⁰ **And Jesus said unto him, Friend, wherefore art thou come? Then came they, and laid hands on Jesus and took him.**

ANGELS ON POST THE WHOLE TIME JUST LIKE THOSE GIVEN CHARGE OVER YOU!

- **Matthew 26:51 – 64** ⁵¹ And, behold, one of them which were with Jesus stretched out his hand, and drew his sword, and struck a servant of the high priest's, and smote off his ear.
- ⁵² Then said Jesus unto him, Put up again thy sword into his place: for all they that take the sword shall perish with the sword.
- ⁵³ Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to my Father, and he shall presently give me more than twelve legions of angels?
- ⁵⁴ But how then shall the scriptures be fulfilled, that thus it must be?
- ⁵⁵ In that same hour said Jesus to the multitudes, Are ye come out as against a thief with swords and staves for to take me? I sat daily with you teaching in the temple, and ye laid no hold on me.
- ⁵⁶ But all this was done, that the scriptures of the prophets might be fulfilled. Then all the disciples forsook him, and fled.
- ⁵⁷ And they that had laid hold on Jesus led him away to Caiaphas the high priest, where the scribes and the elders were assembled.
- ⁵⁸ But Peter followed him afar off unto the high priest's palace, and went in, and sat with the servants, to see the end.
- ⁵⁹ Now the chief priests, and elders, and all the council, sought false witness against Jesus, to put him to death;
- ⁶⁰ But found none: yea, though many false witnesses came, yet found they none. At the last came two false witnesses,
- ⁶¹ And said, This fellow said, I am able to destroy the temple of God, and to build it in three days.
- ⁶² And the high priest arose, and said unto him, Answerest thou nothing? what is it which these witness against thee?
- ⁶³ But Jesus held his peace, And the high priest answered and said unto him, I adjure thee by the living God, that thou tell us whether thou be the Christ, the Son of God.
- ⁶⁴ Jesus saith unto him, Thou hast said: nevertheless I say unto you, Hereafter shall ye see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.

JUDAS ISCARIOT

THE BETRAYER....BUT PETER AS A CLOSE SECOND...

- **Matthew 26:65 – 75** ⁶⁵ Then the high priest rent his clothes, saying, He hath spoken blasphemy; what further need have we of witnesses? behold, now ye have heard his blasphemy.
- ⁶⁶ What think ye? They answered and said, He is guilty of death.
- ⁶⁷ Then did they spit in his face, and buffeted him; and others smote him with the palms of their hands,
- ⁶⁸ Saying, Prophecy unto us, thou Christ, Who is he that smote thee?
- ⁶⁹ Now Peter sat without in the palace: and a damsel came unto him, saying, Thou also wast with Jesus of Galilee.
- ⁷⁰ But he denied before them all, saying, I know not what thou sayest.
- ⁷¹ And when he was gone out into the porch, another maid saw him, and said unto them that were there, This fellow was also with Jesus of Nazareth.
- ⁷² And again he denied with an oath, I do not know the man.
- ⁷³ And after a while came unto him they that stood by, and said to Peter, Surely thou also art one of them; for thy speech bewrayeth thee.
- ⁷⁴ Then began he to curse and to swear, saying, I know not the man. And immediately the cock crew.
- ⁷⁵ And Peter remembered the word of Jesus, which said unto him, Before the cock crow, thou shalt deny me thrice. And he went out, and wept bitterly.

JUDAS ISCARIOT

THE BETRAYER....BUT NOT ONLY THE BETRAYER...REMORSEFUL?

- **Matthew 27:1 – 12** When the morning was come, all the chief priests and elders of the people took counsel against Jesus to put him to death:
- ² And when they had bound him, they led him away, and delivered him to Pontius Pilate the governor.
- ³ Then Judas, which had betrayed him, when he saw that he was condemned, repented himself, and brought again the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders,
- ⁴ Saying, I have sinned in that I have betrayed the innocent blood. And they said, What is that to us? see thou to that.
- ⁵ And he cast down the pieces of silver in the temple, and departed, and went and hanged himself.
- ⁶ And the chief priests took the silver pieces, and said, It is not lawful for to put them into the treasury, because it is the price of blood.
- ⁷ And they took counsel, and bought with them the potter's field, to bury strangers in.
- ⁸ Wherefore that field was called, The field of blood, unto this day.
- ⁹ Then was fulfilled that which was spoken by Jeremy the prophet, saying, And they took the thirty pieces of silver, the price of him that was valued, whom they of the children of Israel did value;
- ¹⁰ And gave them for the potter's field, as the Lord appointed me.
- ¹¹ And Jesus stood before the governor: and the governor asked him, saying, Art thou the King of the Jews? And Jesus said unto him, Thou sayest.
- ¹² And when he was accused of the chief priests and elders, he answered nothing.

**JUDAS ISCARIOT
THE BETRAYER....BUT NOT ONLY THE BETRAYER**

- **Mark 3: 14 – 20** ¹⁴ And he ordained twelve, that they should be with him, and that he might send them forth to preach,
- ¹⁵ And to have power to heal sicknesses, and to cast out devils:
- ¹⁶ And Simon he surnamed Peter;
- ¹⁷ And James the son of Zebedee, and John the brother of James; and he surnamed them Boanerges, which is, The sons of thunder:
- ¹⁸ And Andrew, and Philip, and Bartholomew, and Matthew, and Thomas, and James the son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus, and Simon the Canaanite,
- ¹⁹ And Judas Iscariot, which also betrayed him: and they went into an house.
- ²⁰ And the multitude cometh together again, so that they could not so much as eat bread.

JUDAS ISCARIOT

THE BETRAYER...BUT “CONVENIENT”

- **Mark 14: 10 – 21** ¹⁰ And Judas Iscariot, one of the twelve, went unto the chief priests, to betray him unto them.
- ¹¹ And when they heard it, they were glad, and promised to give him money. And he sought how he might conveniently betray him.
- ¹² And the first day of unleavened bread, when they killed the passover, his disciples said unto him, Where wilt thou that we go and prepare that thou mayest eat the passover?
- ¹³ And he sendeth forth two of his disciples, and saith unto them, Go ye into the city, and there shall meet you a man bearing a pitcher of water: follow him.
- ¹⁴ And wheresoever he shall go in, say ye to the goodman of the house, The Master saith, Where is the guestchamber, where I shall eat the passover with my disciples?
- ¹⁵ And he will shew you a large upper room furnished and prepared: there make ready for us.
- ¹⁶ And his disciples went forth, and came into the city, and found as he had said unto them: and they made ready the passover.
- ¹⁷ And in the evening he cometh with the twelve.
- ¹⁸ And as they sat and did eat, Jesus said, Verily I say unto you, One of you which eateth with me shall betray me.
- ¹⁹ And they began to be sorrowful, and to say unto him one by one, Is it I? and another said, Is it I?
- ²⁰ And he answered and said unto them, It is one of the twelve, that dippeth with me in the dish.
- ²¹ The Son of man indeed goeth, as it is written of him: but woe to that man by whom the Son of man is betrayed! good were it for that man if he had never been born.

JUDAS ISCARIOT

THE BETRAYER....BUT NOT ONLY THE BETRAYER...A SINGER?

- **Mark 14: 22 – 34** ²² And as they did eat, Jesus took bread, and blessed, and brake it, and gave to them, and said, Take, eat: this is my body.
- ²³ And he took the cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them: and they all drank of it.
- ²⁴ And he said unto them, This is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many.
- ²⁵ Verily I say unto you, I will drink no more of the fruit of the vine, until that day that I drink it new in the kingdom of God.
- ²⁶ **And when they had sung an hymn, they went out into the mount of Olives.**
- ²⁷ **And Jesus saith unto them, All ye shall be offended because of me this night: for it is written, I will smite the shepherd, and the sheep shall be scattered.**
- ²⁸ **But after that I am risen, I will go before you into Galilee.**
- ²⁹ **But Peter said unto him, Although all shall be offended, yet will not I.**
- ³⁰ **And Jesus saith unto him, Verily I say unto thee, That this day, even in this night, before the cock crow twice, thou shalt deny me thrice.**
- ³¹ **But he spake the more vehemently, If I should die with thee, I will not deny thee in any wise. Likewise also said they all.**
- ³² **And they came to a place which was named Gethsemane: and he saith to his disciples, Sit ye here, while I shall pray.**
- ³³ And he taketh with him Peter and James and John, and began to be sore amazed, and to be very heavy;
- ³⁴ And saith unto them, My soul is exceeding sorrowful unto death: tarry ye here, and watch.

JUDAS ISCARIOT

LAY YOUR HANDS ON ME...HMM...NOT!

- **Mark 14: 35 – 53** ³⁵ And he went forward a little, and fell on the ground, and prayed that, if it were possible, the hour might pass from him.
- ³⁶ And he said, Abba, Father, all things are possible unto thee; take away this cup from me: nevertheless not what I will, but what thou wilt.
- ³⁷ And he cometh, and findeth them sleeping, and saith unto Peter, Simon, sleepest thou? couldest not thou watch one hour?
- ³⁸ Watch ye and pray, lest ye enter into temptation. The spirit truly is ready, but the flesh is weak.
- ³⁹ And again he went away, and prayed, and spake the same words.
- ⁴⁰ And when he returned, he found them asleep again, (for their eyes were heavy,) neither wist they what to answer him.
- ⁴¹ **And he cometh the third time, and saith unto them, Sleep on now, and take your rest: it is enough, the hour is come; behold, the Son of man is betrayed into the hands of sinners.**
- ⁴² **Rise up, let us go; lo, he that betrayeth me is at hand.**
- ⁴³ **And immediately, while he yet spake, cometh Judas, one of the twelve, and with him a great multitude with swords and staves, from the chief priests and the scribes and the elders.**
- ⁴⁴ **And he that betrayed him had given them a token, saying, Whomsoever I shall kiss, that same is he; take him, and lead him away safely.**
- ⁴⁵ **And as soon as he was come, he goeth straightway to him, and saith, Master, master; and kissed him.**
- ⁴⁶ **And they laid their hands on him, and took him.**
- ⁴⁷ And one of them that stood by drew a sword, and smote a servant of the high priest, and cut off his ear.
- ⁴⁸ And Jesus answered and said unto them, Are ye come out, as against a thief, with swords and with staves to take me?
- ⁴⁹ I was daily with you in the temple teaching, and ye took me not: but the scriptures must be fulfilled.
- ⁵⁰ And they all forsook him, and fled.
- ⁵¹ And there followed him a certain young man, having a linen cloth cast about his naked body; and the young men laid hold on him:
- ⁵² And he left the linen cloth, and fled from them naked.
- ⁵³ And they led Jesus away to the high priest: and with him were assembled all the chief priests and the elders and the scribes.

BETRAYED AND DENIED

- **Mark 14: 60 – 72** ⁶⁰ And the high priest stood up in the midst, and asked Jesus, saying, Answerest thou nothing? what is it which these witness against thee?
- ⁶¹ But he held his peace, and answered nothing. Again the high priest asked him, and said unto him, Art thou the Christ, the Son of the Blessed?
- ⁶² And Jesus said, I am: and ye shall see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.
- ⁶³ Then the high priest rent his clothes, and saith, What need we any further witnesses?
- ⁶⁴ Ye have heard the blasphemy: what think ye? And they all condemned him to be guilty of death.
- ⁶⁵ And some began to spit on him, and to cover his face, and to buffet him, and to say unto him, Prophecy: and the servants did strike him with the palms of their hands.
- ⁶⁶ And as Peter was beneath in the palace, there cometh one of the maids of the high priest:
- ⁶⁷ And when she saw Peter warming himself, she looked upon him, and said, And thou also wast with Jesus of Nazareth.
- ⁶⁸ But he denied, saying, I know not, neither understand I what thou sayest. And he went out into the porch; and the cock crew.
- ⁶⁹ And a maid saw him again, and began to say to them that stood by, This is one of them.
- ⁷⁰ And he denied it again. And a little after, they that stood by said again to Peter, Surely thou art one of them: for thou art a Galilaean, and thy speech agreeth thereto.
- ⁷¹ But he began to curse and to swear, saying, I know not this man of whom ye speak.
- ⁷² And the second time the cock crew. And Peter called to mind the word that Jesus said unto him, Before the cock crow twice, thou shalt deny me thrice. And when he thought thereon, he wept.

JUDAS ISCARIOT THE BETRAYER...OR THE TRAITOR?

- **Luke 6:13 – 19** ¹³ And when it was day, he called unto him his disciples: and of them he chose twelve, whom also he named apostles;
- ¹⁴ Simon, (whom he also named Peter,) and Andrew his brother, James and John, Philip and Bartholomew,
- ¹⁵ Matthew and Thomas, James the son of Alphaeus, and Simon called Zelotes,
- ¹⁶ And Judas the brother of James, **and Judas Iscariot, which also was the traitor.**
- ¹⁷ And he came down with them, and stood in the plain, and the company of his disciples, and a great multitude of people out of all Judaea and Jerusalem, and from the sea coast of Tyre and Sidon, which came to hear him, and to be healed of their diseases;
- ¹⁸ And they that were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed.
- ¹⁹ And the whole multitude sought to touch him: for there went virtue out of him, and healed them all.

JUDAS ISCARIOT

THE ROLE OF SATAN

- **Luke 22:1 – 18** Now the feast of unleavened bread drew nigh, which is called the Passover.
- ² And the chief priests and scribes sought how they might kill him; for they feared the people.
- ³ Then entered Satan into Judas surnamed Iscariot, being of the number of the twelve.
- ⁴ And he went his way, and communed with the chief priests and captains, how he might betray him unto them.
- ⁵ And they were glad, and covenanted to give him money.
- ⁶ And he promised, and sought opportunity to betray him unto them in the absence of the multitude.
- ⁷ Then came the day of unleavened bread, when the passover must be killed.
- ⁸ And he sent Peter and John, saying, Go and prepare us the passover, that we may eat.
- ⁹ And they said unto him, Where wilt thou that we prepare?
- ¹⁰ And he said unto them, Behold, when ye are entered into the city, there shall a man meet you, bearing a pitcher of water; follow him into the house where he entereth in.
- ¹¹ And ye shall say unto the goodman of the house, The Master saith unto thee, Where is the guestchamber, where I shall eat the passover with my disciples?
- ¹² And he shall shew you a large upper room furnished: there make ready.
- ¹³ And they went, and found as he had said unto them: and they made ready the passover.
- ¹⁴ And when the hour was come, he sat down, and the twelve apostles with him.
- ¹⁵ And he said unto them, With desire I have desired to eat this passover with you before I suffer:
- ¹⁶ For I say unto you, I will not any more eat thereof, until it be fulfilled in the kingdom of God.
- ¹⁷ And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, Take this, and divide it among yourselves:
- ¹⁸ For I say unto you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine, until the kingdom of God shall come.

JUDAS ISCARIOT

THE BETRAYER....BUT NOT ONLY THE BETRAYER

- **Luke 22:19 – 30** ¹⁹ And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake it, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me.
- ²⁰ Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood, which is shed for you.
- ²¹ But, behold, the hand of him that betrayeth me is with me on the table.
- ²² And truly the Son of man goeth, as it was determined: but woe unto that man by whom he is betrayed!
- ²³ And they began to enquire among themselves, which of them it was that should do this thing.
- ²⁴ And there was also a strife among them, which of them should be accounted the greatest.
- ²⁵ And he said unto them, The kings of the Gentiles exercise lordship over them; and they that exercise authority upon them are called benefactors.
- ²⁶ But ye shall not be so: but he that is greatest among you, let him be as the younger; and he that is chief, as he that doth serve.
- ²⁷ For whether is greater, he that sitteth at meat, or he that serveth? is not he that sitteth at meat? but I am among you as he that serveth.
- ²⁸ Ye are they which have continued with me in my temptations.
- ²⁹ And I appoint unto you a kingdom, as my Father hath appointed unto me;
- ³⁰ That ye may eat and drink at my table in my kingdom, and sit on thrones judging the twelve tribes of Israel.

JUDAS ISCARIOT

THE BETRAYER...SILVER OR A KISS

- **Luke 22:47 – 60** ⁴⁷ And while he yet spake, behold a multitude, and he that was called Judas, one of the twelve, went before them, and drew near unto Jesus to kiss him.
- ⁴⁸ But Jesus said unto him, Judas, betrayest thou the Son of man with a kiss?
- ⁴⁹ When they which were about him saw what would follow, they said unto him, Lord, shall we smite with the sword?
- ⁵⁰ And one of them smote the servant of the high priest, and cut off his right ear.
- ⁵¹ And Jesus answered and said, Suffer ye thus far. And he touched his ear, and healed him.
- ⁵² Then Jesus said unto the chief priests, and captains of the temple, and the elders, which were come to him, Be ye come out, as against a thief, with swords and staves?
- ⁵³ When I was daily with you in the temple, ye stretched forth no hands against me: but this is your hour, and the power of darkness.
- ⁵⁴ Then took they him, and led him, and brought him into the high priest's house. And Peter followed afar off.
- ⁵⁵ And when they had kindled a fire in the midst of the hall, and were set down together, Peter sat down among them.
- ⁵⁶ But a certain maid beheld him as he sat by the fire, and earnestly looked upon him, and said, This man was also with him.
- ⁵⁷ And he denied him, saying, Woman, I know him not.
- ⁵⁸ And after a little while another saw him, and said, Thou art also of them. And Peter said, Man, I am not.
- ⁵⁹ And about the space of one hour after another confidently affirmed, saying, Of a truth this fellow also was with him: for he is a Galilaean.
- ⁶⁰ And Peter said, Man, I know not what thou sayest. And immediately, while he yet spake, the cock crew.

WAS SIMON PETER A BETRAYER?

- **Luke 22:61 – 71** ⁶¹ And the Lord turned, and looked upon Peter. And Peter remembered the word of the Lord, how he had said unto him, Before the cock crow, thou shalt deny me thrice.
- ⁶² And Peter went out, and wept bitterly.
- ⁶³ And the men that held Jesus mocked him, and smote him.
- ⁶⁴ And when they had blindfolded him, they struck him on the face, and asked him, saying, Prophecy, who is it that smote thee?
- ⁶⁵ And many other things blasphemously spake they against him.
- ⁶⁶ And as soon as it was day, the elders of the people and the chief priests and the scribes came together, and led him into their council, saying,
- ⁶⁷ Art thou the Christ? tell us. And he said unto them, If I tell you, ye will not believe:
- ⁶⁸ And if I also ask you, ye will not answer me, nor let me go.
- ⁶⁹ Hereafter shall the Son of man sit on the right hand of the power of God.
- ⁷⁰ Then said they all, Art thou then the Son of God? And he said unto them, Ye say that I am.
- ⁷¹ And they said, What need we any further witness? for we ourselves have heard of his own mouth.

FLESH AND BLOOD BUT NOT HIS!

- **John 6:47 – 60** ⁴⁷ Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me hath everlasting life.
- ⁴⁸ I am that bread of life.
- ⁴⁹ Your fathers did eat manna in the wilderness, and are dead.
- ⁵⁰ This is the bread which cometh down from heaven, that a man may eat thereof, and not die.
- ⁵¹ I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.
- ⁵² The Jews therefore strove among themselves, saying, How can this man give us his flesh to eat?
- ⁵³ Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink his blood, ye have no life in you.
- ⁵⁴ Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day.
- ⁵⁵ For my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed.
- ⁵⁶ He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him.
- ⁵⁷ As the living Father hath sent me, and I live by the Father: so he that eateth me, even he shall live by me.
- ⁵⁸ This is that bread which came down from heaven: not as your fathers did eat manna, and are dead: he that eateth of this bread shall live for ever.
- ⁵⁹ These things said he in the synagogue, as he taught in Capernaum.
- ⁶⁰ Many therefore of his disciples, when they had heard this, said, This is an hard saying; who can hear it?

JUDAS ISCARIOT A DEVIL?

- **John 6:61 – 71** ⁶¹ When Jesus knew in himself that his disciples murmured at it, he said unto them, Doth this offend you?
- ⁶² What and if ye shall see the Son of man ascend up where he was before?
- ⁶³ It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.
- ⁶⁴ But there are some of you that believe not. For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were that believed not, and who should betray him.
- ⁶⁵ And he said, Therefore said I unto you, that no man can come unto me, except it were given unto him of my Father.
- ⁶⁶ From that time many of his disciples went back, and walked no more with him.
- ⁶⁷ Then said Jesus unto the twelve, Will ye also go away?
- ⁶⁸ Then Simon Peter answered him, Lord, to whom shall we go? thou hast the words of eternal life.
- ⁶⁹ And we believe and are sure that thou art that Christ, the Son of the living God.
- ⁷⁰ **Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil?**
- ⁷¹ **He spake of Judas Iscariot the son of Simon: for he it was that should betray him, being one of the twelve.**

JUDAS ISCARIOT

WHO ARE THE POOR?

- **John 12:1 – 11** Then Jesus six days before the passover came to Bethany, where Lazarus was, which had been dead, whom he raised from the dead.
- ² There they made him a supper; and Martha served: but Lazarus was one of them that sat at the table with him.
- ³ Then took Mary a pound of ointment of spikenard, very costly, and anointed the feet of Jesus, and wiped his feet with her hair: and the house was filled with the odour of the ointment.
- ⁴ Then saith one of his disciples, Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, which should betray him,
- ⁵ Why was not this ointment sold for three hundred pence, and given to the poor?
- ⁶ This he said, not that he cared for the poor; but because he was a thief, and had the bag, and bare what was put therein.
- ⁷ Then said Jesus, Let her alone: against the day of my burying hath she kept this.
- ⁸ For the poor always ye have with you; but me ye have not always.
- ⁹ Much people of the Jews therefore knew that he was there: and they came not for Jesus' sake only, but that they might see Lazarus also, whom he had raised from the dead.
- ¹⁰ But the chief priests consulted that they might put Lazarus also to death;
- ¹¹ Because that by reason of him many of the Jews went away, and believed on Jesus.

JUDAS ISCARIOT

CHRIST SERVED HIM EVEN THOUGH HE KNEW HE'S BETRAY HIM

- **John 13:1 – 19** Now before the feast of the passover, when Jesus knew that his hour was come that he should depart out of this world unto the Father, having loved his own which were in the world, he loved them unto the end.
- ² And supper being ended, the devil having now put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, to betray him;
- ³ Jesus knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands, and that he was come from God, and went to God;
- ⁴ He riseth from supper, and laid aside his garments; and took a towel, and girded himself.
- ⁵ After that he poureth water into a bason, and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel wherewith he was girded.
- ⁶ Then cometh he to Simon Peter: and Peter saith unto him, Lord, dost thou wash my feet?
- ⁷ Jesus answered and said unto him, What I do thou knowest not now; but thou shalt know hereafter.
- ⁸ Peter saith unto him, Thou shalt never wash my feet. Jesus answered him, If I wash thee not, thou hast no part with me.
- ⁹ Simon Peter saith unto him, Lord, not my feet only, but also my hands and my head.
- ¹⁰ **Jesus saith to him, He that is washed needeth not save to wash his feet, but is clean every whit: and ye are clean, but not all.**
- ¹¹ **For he knew who should betray him; therefore said he, Ye are not all clean.**
- ¹² **So after he had washed their feet, and had taken his garments, and was set down again, he said unto them, Know ye what I have done to you?**
- ¹³ **Ye call me Master and Lord: and ye say well; for so I am.**
- ¹⁴ If I then, your Lord and Master, have washed your feet; ye also ought to wash one another's feet.
- ¹⁵ For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you.
- ¹⁶ Verily, verily, I say unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord; neither he that is sent greater than he that sent him.
- ¹⁷ If ye know these things, happy are ye if ye do them.
- ¹⁸ I speak not of you all: I know whom I have chosen: but that the scripture may be fulfilled, He that eateth bread with me hath lifted up his heel against me.
- ¹⁹ Now I tell you before it come, that, when it is come to pass, ye may believe that I am he.

JUDAS ISCARIOT EATING AND RUNNING

- **John 13:20 – 32** ²⁰ Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that receiveth whomsoever I send receiveth me; and he that receiveth me receiveth him that sent me.
- ²¹ When Jesus had thus said, he was troubled in spirit, and testified, and said, Verily, verily, I say unto you, that one of you shall betray me.
- ²² Then the disciples looked one on another, doubting of whom he spake.
- ²³ Now there was leaning on Jesus' bosom one of his disciples, whom Jesus loved.
- ²⁴ Simon Peter therefore beckoned to him, that he should ask who it should be of whom he spake.
- ²⁵ He then lying on Jesus' breast saith unto him, Lord, who is it?
- ²⁶ Jesus answered, He it is, to whom I shall give a sop, when I have dipped it. And when he had dipped the sop, he gave it to Judas Iscariot, the son of Simon.
- ²⁷ And after the sop Satan entered into him. Then said Jesus unto him, That thou doest, do quickly.
- ²⁸ Now no man at the table knew for what intent he spake this unto him.
- ²⁹ For some of them thought, because Judas had the bag, that Jesus had said unto him, Buy those things that we have need of against the feast; or, that he should give something to the poor.
- ³⁰ He then having received the sop went immediately out: and it was night.
- ³¹ Therefore, when he was gone out, Jesus said, Now is the Son of man glorified, and God is glorified in him.
- ³² If God be glorified in him, God shall also glorify him in himself, and shall straightway glorify him.

JUDAS ISCARIOT

THE BETRAYER....BUT NEVER A SECRET FROM GOD

- **John 18:1 – 18** When Jesus had spoken these words, he went forth with his disciples over the brook Cedron, where was a garden, into the which he entered, and his disciples.
- ² And Judas also, which betrayed him, knew the place: for Jesus oftentimes resorted thither with his disciples.
- ³ Judas then, having received a band of men and officers from the chief priests and Pharisees, cometh thither with lanterns and torches and weapons.
- ⁴ Jesus therefore, knowing all things that should come upon him, went forth, and said unto them, Whom seek ye?
- ⁵ They answered him, Jesus of Nazareth. Jesus saith unto them, I am he. And Judas also, which betrayed him, stood with them.
- ⁶ As soon then as he had said unto them, I am he, they went backward, and fell to the ground.
- ⁷ Then asked he them again, Whom seek ye? And they said, Jesus of Nazareth.
- ⁸ Jesus answered, I have told you that I am he: if therefore ye seek me, let these go their way:
- ⁹ That the saying might be fulfilled, which he spake, Of them which thou gavest me have I lost none.
- ¹⁰ Then Simon Peter having a sword drew it, and smote the high priest's servant, and cut off his right ear. The servant's name was Malchus.
- ¹¹ Then said Jesus unto Peter, Put up thy sword into the sheath: the cup which my Father hath given me, shall I not drink it?
- ¹² Then the band and the captain and officers of the Jews took Jesus, and bound him,
- ¹³ And led him away to Annas first; for he was father in law to Caiaphas, which was the high priest that same year.
- ¹⁴ Now Caiaphas was he, which gave counsel to the Jews, that it was expedient that one man should die for the people.
- ¹⁵ And Simon Peter followed Jesus, and so did another disciple: that disciple was known unto the high priest, and went in with Jesus into the palace of the high priest.
- ¹⁶ But Peter stood at the door without. Then went out that other disciple, which was known unto the high priest, and spake unto her that kept the door, and brought in Peter.
- ¹⁷ Then saith the damsel that kept the door unto Peter, Art not thou also one of this man's disciples? He saith, I am not.
- ¹⁸ And the servants and officers stood there, who had made a fire of coals; for it was cold: and they warmed themselves: and Peter stood with them, and warmed himself.

HIGH PRIEST AND PETER'S DENIAL

- **John 18:19 – 32** ¹⁹The high priest then asked Jesus of his disciples, and of his doctrine.
- ²⁰ Jesus answered him, I spake openly to the world; I ever taught in the synagogue, and in the temple, whither the Jews always resort; and in secret have I said nothing.
- ²¹ Why askest thou me? ask them which heard me, what I have said unto them: behold, they know what I said.
- ²² And when he had thus spoken, one of the officers which stood by struck Jesus with the palm of his hand, saying, Answerest thou the high priest so?
- ²³ Jesus answered him, If I have spoken evil, bear witness of the evil: but if well, why smitest thou me?
- ²⁴ Now Annas had sent him bound unto Caiaphas the high priest.
- ²⁵ And Simon Peter stood and warmed himself. They said therefore unto him, Art not thou also one of his disciples? He denied it, and said, I am not.
- ²⁶ One of the servants of the high priest, being his kinsman whose ear Peter cut off, saith, Did not I see thee in the garden with him?
- ²⁷ Peter then denied again: and immediately the cock crew.
- ²⁸ Then led they Jesus from Caiaphas unto the hall of judgment: and it was early; and they themselves went not into the judgment hall, lest they should be defiled; but that they might eat the passover.
- ²⁹ Pilate then went out unto them, and said, What accusation bring ye against this man?
- ³⁰ They answered and said unto him, If he were not a malefactor, we would not have delivered him up unto thee.
- ³¹ Then said Pilate unto them, Take ye him, and judge him according to your law. The Jews therefore said unto him, It is not lawful for us to put any man to death:
- ³² That the saying of Jesus might be fulfilled, which he spake, signifying what death he should die.
- ³³ Then Pilate entered into the judgment hall again, and called Jesus, and said unto him, Art thou the King of the Jews?
- ³⁴ Jesus answered him, Sayest thou this thing of thyself, or did others tell it thee of me?
- ³⁵ Pilate answered, Am I a Jew? Thine own nation and the chief priests have delivered thee unto me: what hast thou done?
- ³⁶ Jesus answered, My kingdom is not of this world: if my kingdom were of this world, then would my servants fight, that I should not be delivered to the Jews: but now is my kingdom not from hence.
- ³⁷ Pilate therefore said unto him, Art thou a king then? Jesus answered, Thou sayest that I am a king. To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. Every one that is of the truth heareth my voice.
- ³⁸ Pilate saith unto him, What is truth? And when he had said this, he went out again unto the Jews, and saith unto them, I find in him no fault at all.

JESUS ASCENDING TO HEAVEN AND THE PROMISE OF THE HOLY GHOST

- **Acts 1: 1 – 13** The former treatise have I made, O Theophilus, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach,
- ² Until the day in which he was taken up, after that he through the Holy Ghost had given commandments unto the apostles whom he had chosen:
- ³ To whom also he shewed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God:
- ⁴ And, being assembled together with them, commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which, saith he, ye have heard of me.
- ⁵ For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence.
- ⁶ When they therefore were come together, they asked of him, saying, Lord, wilt thou at this time restore again the kingdom to Israel?
- ⁷ And he said unto them, It is not for you to know the times or the seasons, which the Father hath put in his own power.
- ⁸ But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.
- ⁹ And when he had spoken these things, while they beheld, he was taken up; and a cloud received him out of their sight.
- ¹⁰ And while they looked stedfastly toward heaven as he went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel;
- ¹¹ Which also said, Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? this same Jesus, which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven.
- ¹² Then returned they unto Jerusalem from the mount called Olivet, which is from Jerusalem a sabbath day's journey.
- ¹³ And when they were come in, they went up into an upper room, where abode both Peter, and James, and John, and Andrew, Philip, and Thomas, Bartholomew, and Matthew, James the son of Alphaeus, and Simon Zelotes, and Judas the brother of James.

CASTING LOTS FOR JUDAS'S REPLACEMENT

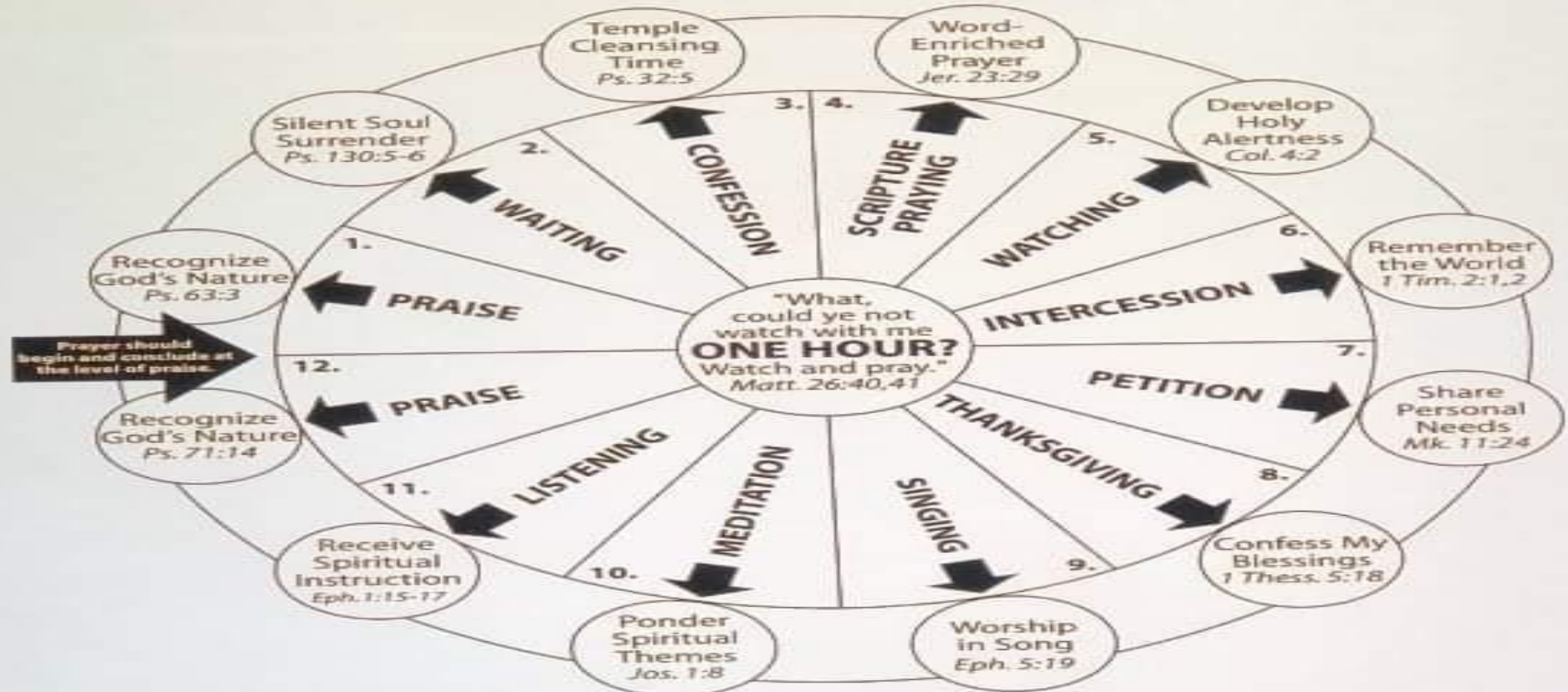
- **Acts 1: 14– 26** ¹⁴ These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication, with the women, and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brethren.
- ¹⁵ And in those days Peter stood up in the midst of the disciples, and said, (the number of names together were about an hundred and twenty,)
- ¹⁶ Men and brethren, this scripture must needs have been fulfilled, which the Holy Ghost by the mouth of David spake before concerning Judas, which was guide to them that took Jesus.
- ¹⁷ For he was numbered with us, and had obtained part of this ministry.
- ¹⁸ Now this man purchased a field with the reward of iniquity; and falling headlong, he burst asunder in the midst, and all his bowels gushed out.
- ¹⁹ And it was known unto all the dwellers at Jerusalem; insomuch as that field is called in their proper tongue, Aceldama, that is to say, The field of blood.
- ²⁰ For it is written in the book of Psalms, Let his habitation be desolate, and let no man dwell therein: and his bishoprick let another take.
- ²¹ Wherefore of these men which have companied with us all the time that the Lord Jesus went in and out among us,
- ²² Beginning from the baptism of John, unto that same day that he was taken up from us, must one be ordained to be a witness with us of his resurrection.
- ²³ And they appointed two, Joseph called Barsabas, who was surnamed Justus, and Matthias.
- ²⁴ **And they prayed, and said, Thou, Lord, which knowest the hearts of all men, shew whether of these two thou hast chosen,**
- ²⁵ **That he may take part of this ministry and apostleship, from which Judas by transgression fell, that he might go to his own place.**
- ²⁶ **And they gave forth their lots; and the lot fell upon Matthias; and he was numbered with the eleven apostles.**

PETER AFTER THE DENIAL AND AFTER RECEIVING THE HOLY GHOST

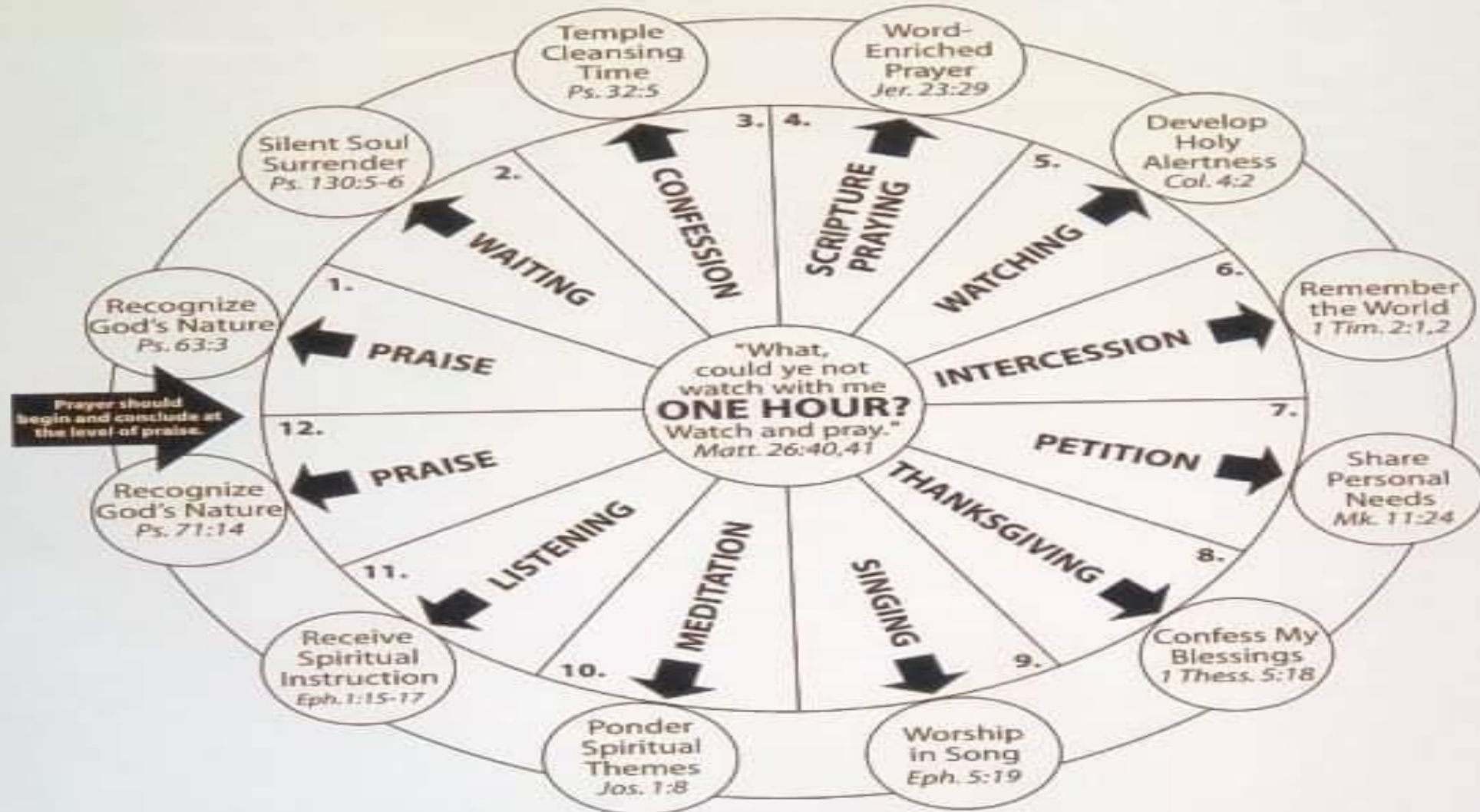
- **Acts 5: 29– 42** Then Peter and the other apostles answered and said, We ought to obey God rather than men.
- ³⁰ The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom ye slew and hanged on a tree.
- ³¹ Him hath God exalted with his right hand to be a Prince and a Saviour, for to give repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins.
- ³² And we are his witnesses of these things; and so is also the Holy Ghost, whom God hath given to them that obey him.
- ³³ When they heard that, they were cut to the heart, and took counsel to slay them.
- ³⁴ Then stood there up one in the council, a Pharisee, named Gamaliel, a doctor of the law, had in reputation among all the people, and commanded to put the apostles forth a little space;
- ³⁵ And said unto them, Ye men of Israel, take heed to yourselves what ye intend to do as touching these men.
- ³⁶ For before these days rose up Theudas, boasting himself to be somebody; to whom a number of men, about four hundred, joined themselves: who was slain; and all, as many as obeyed him, were scattered, and brought to nought.
- ³⁷ After this man rose up Judas of Galilee in the days of the taxing, and drew away much people after him: he also perished; and all, even as many as obeyed him, were dispersed.
- ³⁸ And now I say unto you, Refrain from these men, and let them alone: for if this counsel or this work be of men, it will come to nought:
- ³⁹ But if it be of God, ye cannot overthrow it; lest haply ye be found even to fight against God.
- ⁴⁰ And to him they agreed: and when they had called the apostles, and beaten them, they commanded that they should not speak in the name of Jesus, and let them go.
- ⁴¹ And they departed from the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer shame for his name.
- ⁴² And daily in the temple, and in every house, they ceased not to teach and preach Jesus Christ.
